

Some of the psalms are *thank you* psalms which thank God for lots of different things. Often the psalm writers remember hard times and say thank you to God for helping them through. Psalm 30 is a good example. Here is verse 1:

I praise you, LORD, because you have saved me and kept my enemies from gloating over me.



In other Psalms the writers just say thank you for what God has done for them!

- ⁵The LORD is good! His love and faithfulness will last forever!
