Dear Prime Minister

Discrimination does not belong in faith-based schools

We write as Principals and Heads representing a range of Independent faith-based schools across denominations. We are convinced that our faith-based schools can maintain their religious values, beliefs and ethos without recourse to discrimination based on sexual orientation or gender identity.

We are concerned there is still public confusion about what legal rights faith-based schools require, in order to maintain their ethos and identity. We are also deeply disturbed by ongoing reports of anxiety and distress among our students, alumni, parents and others in the wider community.

In our view, religious exemptions that permit discrimination have no place in our schools.

We are pleased you have publicly committed to remove at least one of these exemptions by the end of the year, and assure you of our support for the removal of <u>all</u> unnecessary exemptions in the federal *Sex Discrimination Act*.

Discrimination in any form is unacceptable. It jeopardises the safe and supportive school environments that are so central to our mission. It undermines the potential of individuals and the cohesion of communities.

We know how damaging discrimination can become when young people in our schools are bullied, excluded and made to feel inferior. We do not want this to occur. The wellbeing and pastoral care of our young people is paramount, as is the wellbeing and pastoral care of our staff, and our wider school communities.

Our shared religious ethos and values define the nature of our communities, and those same values call us to welcome families, however they are formed and whatever they look like. Our schools are deeply enriched by this diversity. This welcome to <u>all</u> people gives physical expression to the values and ethos we espouse.

We cherish being faith-based schools, and we proudly talk about what that means with the community. This includes the participation of students and staff in the whole life of our schools: in worship and ritual, in learning, in community service, and in our care for each other.

All these are expressions of a deeply inclusive commitment to our faith-based ethos and values. All of these we can do without discrimination. In fact, we must.

We urge Parliament to act without delay to remove unnecessary and damaging exemptions currently provided in the Sex Discrimination Act. The Parliament can remove confusion by conveying in simple terms that faith-based schools do not need to discriminate in order to operate.
